On the Fruit section, berries are really coming up nicely with fantastic French blueberries, Spanish raspberries and strawberries. Stone fruits from North Hemisphere such as Morocco, have started with very nice peached and nectarine although very expensive but will ease in 2 to 3 weeks.

English green asparagus are still glass house. Price has slightly come down... the outdoor crop is about 2 weeks away and will see prices driven down. So hang on there!

French white asparagus are a bit pricey but worth every penny or Euro rather!
